



AITP Omaha Scholarship, in partnership with AIM 2026 Application Forms and Information

Due date July 1, 2026

Several scholarships are now available for the 2026/2027 academic year.

The Omaha chapter of the Association of Information Technology Professionals (AITP), in partnership with AIM, provides academic scholarships to deserving students who are either planning on attending or continuing to attend a college, university, community college, or technical school in Nebraska, Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, North Dakota, or South Dakota, with the goal of achieving an associate's or bachelor's degree in Information Systems, Information Technology, Computer Science, or a related field.

All students pursuing an associate's or bachelor's degree in Information Systems, Information Technology, Computer Science, or a related field are invited to apply. AITP Omaha or Lincoln chapter professional members and their spouses or children, and students who have actively participated in an AIM youth program, are encouraged to apply. Students are eligible for a maximum of two scholarship awards, and no more than one award per academic year.

Instructions for Applicants

All application materials are due July 1, 2026.

Each applicant must submit the following items:

1. Scholarship Application (Form A)
2. **Two Scholarship Recommendations (Form B)**. Applicants **must ensure** that the Scholarship Recommendation forms have been submitted by the recommender prior to the application close date.
3. Current high school or college transcript
